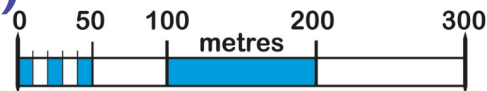

Map Scale 1:5000

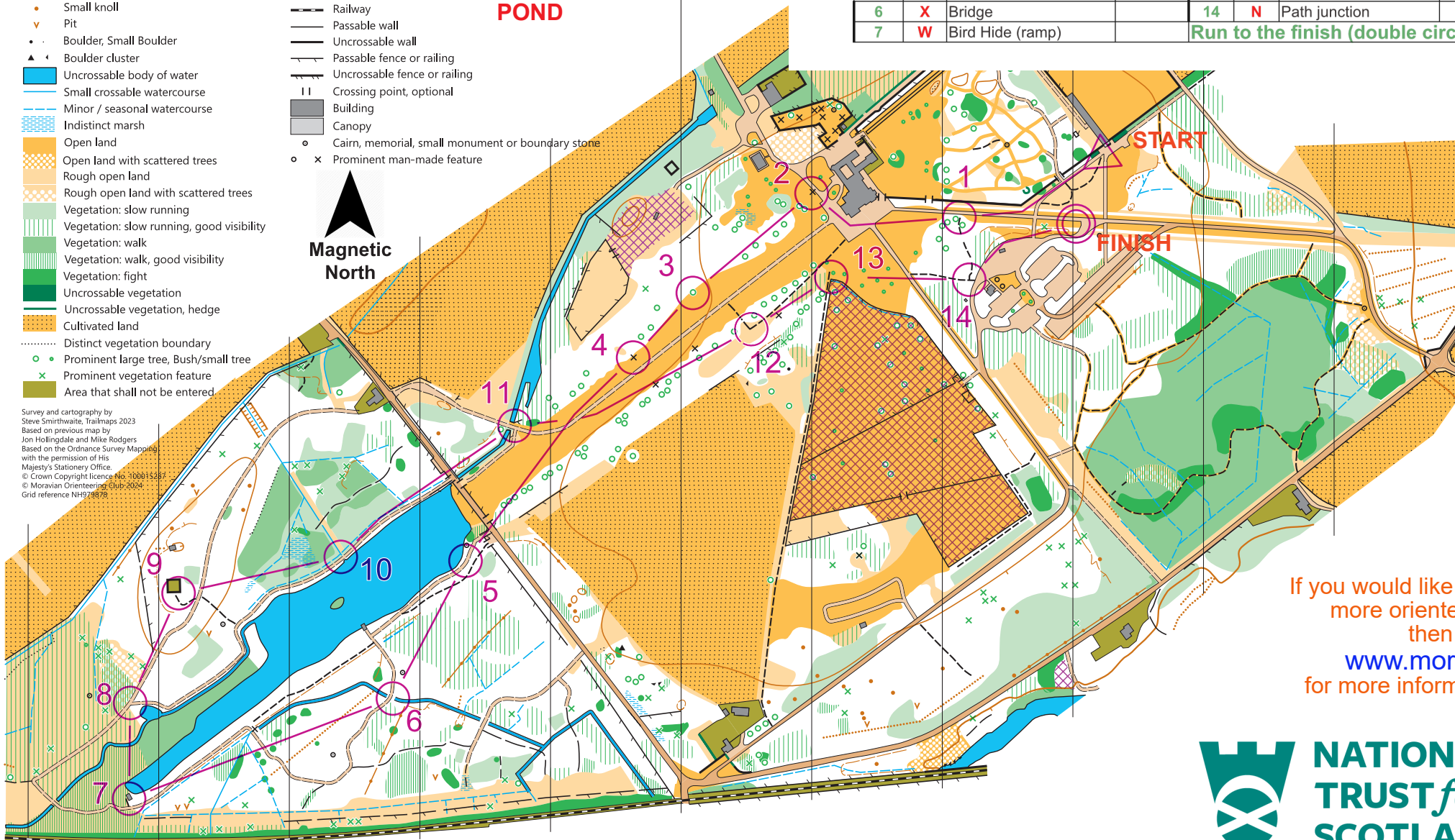


TAKE CARE CROSSING THE ROAD NEAR THE POND
