This new arrangement will be shared with event organisers. - Recording participant's details - it was agreed to amend the event registration form to capture entrant status (BOF, SOA, IND, age etc) so that we can submit accurate levies to BOF/SOA The committee thanked Donald for summarising these key items of financial management and the current balance sheet. 5.	Fixtures and Permissions: - Fixtures — Andrew and David tabled the current proposed fixtures list 25/26 (Appendix 2) and a summary of mapping/map update requirements to service those fixtures. The committee's thanks were extended to Andrew and David. In discussion it was noted that: 1. We consider holding a regional event next spring early summer — potential areas should be assessed for suitability by an independent controller. 2. We need to carefully plan our use of volunteer mappers and ensure that we pay appropriate rates for more major mapping projects.; 3. Our Autumn Urban/Scottish Score weekend would be the major focus for later in 2026; 4. We consider using Aberlour (re-mapped, to include a potential permanent course) for our August Score event/AGM 5. Neil Crookston has agreed to assist David in obtaining permissions for future events. - Event feedback — it was noted that the club made a substantial and very successful contribution to the Scottish Six Days 2025. The Northern Urban league 2025 was a real success too. In addition, we put on a full range of local events, including a well-received indoor event organised and planned by Steve Smirthwaite. Two CATI events (Cooper Park and Grant Park/Cluny) have been held, with the Brodie Castle event postponed due to storm damage. Rescheduled for mid-January Will continues to deliver sessions in Primary schools throughout Moray and is investigating a permanent course in Aberlour.
