



## Final Details – Roseisle North – 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022

### **Car Parking:**

There is no set parking, so participants are asked to find a parking spot on Grant Street (the main street in Burghead) or any street near the Assembly field.

### **Directions:**

- Assembly is at 11814 68652 (What3Words: sprinter.economies.finest.)
- Drive straight into Burghead on the B9013 and you will see the Assembly in a playing field on your left.

### **Assembly:**

When we last visited the Assembly field some travellers were parked up in it. We don't know if they will still be there on Saturday. However, there should be plenty of space for our Assembly. At the Assembly there will be:

- Tent for enquiries and downloading.
- Hired dibbers will be ready for collection here.
- Maps for participants on the Yellow course – **please make sure you collect Yellow maps before going to the Start.**
- Help with entering the event on the day – please bring a card to pay if possible.

### **Start:**

- The Start will involve an approx. 200m walk from Registration. Please allow about 5 minutes to walk to the Start.
- You can start anytime between 1030 and 1200.
- Go to the Start when you are ready and our start team will give you the next available slot.

### **Finish:**

- On finishing, all competitors must report to download in registration – even if you retire and do not complete your course.
- The Finish will involve an approx. 200m walk back to registration/download
- All courses close at 1330 Controls will be removed progressively after this time. At this time, all competitors on the course must return to registration and report to download.

### **Course Information**

- **Light Green – 4.5km, 200m Climb TD4**
- **Orange – 3km, 150m Climb TD3**
- **Yellow – 2.1km, 100m Climb TD2**

### **Additional Information**

- **Out of bounds** – there is a new out of bounds area shown on the map, it affects Orange control 9 and Light Green control 12. Please ensure you respect the oob and use the minor path to the control.
- **Toilets** - There will be no toilet facilities at registration. The nearest public toilets are at the Harbour in Burghead.
- **Other Forest Users** - Please respect other users of the Forest (dog walkers, horse riders and cyclists).
- **Litter.** All competitors are asked to take their litter home with them.
- **Dogs.** Dogs are welcome.
- **Moray Way 100** - We have been informed that there is another event on the same day called the "Moray Way 100" fun run. You may encounter other runners in the forest.



- **Log stacks** – They must not be climbed on as they could fall and injure you or someone else.
